IN REVIEW: FRESHMEN FORWARD

The Freshmen Forward Orientation was held on August 14th-15th. Approximately 180 freshmen attended this year's sessions. The sessions were run by Southwest's Link Crew, a group of successful juniors and seniors who were trained to provide leadership and collaboration, along with Student Services. The Link Leaders worked closely with the freshmen, welcoming them, answering questions to help ease the transition to high school, and providing support. Freshmen were given important information regarding the rules, expectations, and graduation requirements at Southwest, as well as what a typical high school day will look like. The freshmen were also given a chance to tour the building. They received copies of their schedules and were given time to navigate the building and familiarize themselves with their day.

Link Crew will also be out in full force on the first day of school to continue their role as leaders and mentors to the freshmen class. Link Leaders will be available throughout the year to provide continuing support to the freshmen.
